**The European Parliament in Brussels**

*The two-day conference will mark the tenth anniversary of the World Court Advisory Opinion on the threat or use of nuclear weapons. The intention is to identify relevant aspects of International Humanitarian Law and Treaty Obligations clarified by the Opinion.*

*The first day will concentrate on the legal implications of the Advisory Opinion, emphasising developments since 1996. It will start with a review of the Opinion, and a reminder of how nuclear weapons affect people. The rest of the day will consider Nuclear Policy Concepts and the Advisory Opinion, including an examination of the concept of "good faith" in relation to current nuclear weapons policy.*

*The second day will examine the various options for another request to the World Court for a fresh ruling about the legal status of nuclear weapons. The afternoon session will present civil society initiatives linked with a return to the World Court.*
